

Audit Students

Audit Students: A student who registers for credit courses on a non-credit basis. For admission, students must comply with the College admission standards as outlined in the requirements for first-time, transfer, or returning students.

Under no circumstances will audit students receive credits applicable to degree requirements. Tuition and fees for courses audited are the same as those for courses taken for credit. Students may not use federal financial aid for courses that are audited. Health science courses are not eligible to be audited by students at the College, and the appropriate pre-requisite requirements must be met for students wishing to audit a class. Students may not change from "credit" to "audit" or from "audit" to "credit" after the Drop/Add period is over for the term.
